Whether family docs or specialists, DOs are trained to use all the tools of modern medicine and more. They help their patients develop attitudes and lifestyles that don't just fight illness but help to prevent it. They give special attention to how the body's nerves, muscles, bones and other organs work together to influence health. And, through osteopathic manipulative treatment, they encourage the body's natural ability to heal itself.
